Description- The Program Coordinator will support the efforts of the Strawberry Creek Restoration Program. The selected intern will recruit, schedule for training, and coordinate the activities of Student Habitat Restoration Leaders (SHRLs). Intern will also be responsible for promoting and popularizing the Strawberry Creek Restoration Program amongst the Campus population. The efforts of the Program Coordinator will hopefully result in an ongoing program to train and supply a corps of Cal students who will be available to promote and lead volunteer habitat restoration events on University owned open space within the Strawberry Creek, Claremont Creek, and Codornices Creek watersheds.

Qualifications- Candidates should have strong organizational, writing, and verbal skills. Tasks will include public speaking and work outdoors. Ideal candidates will have experience in leading or participating in habitat restoration efforts and knowledge of California flora and fauna; experience working in Bay Area watersheds a plus. Graduate students with completed studies in the environmental and biological fields are strongly encouraged to apply.
