

Energy Incentive Program: \$870K in Payments

The Energy Incentive Program (EIP) is an innovative approach to energy management that gives Operating Units (OUs) a financial incentive to implement energy-saving measures. OUs that use less electricity than allocated will receive an incentive payment, while those that exceed the allocation will incur overage charges beginning in the second year of the program. OUs receive monthly meter reports indicating actual consumption relative to their historic baseline and will receive end-of-year statements and incentive payments totaling over \$870,000. These savings represent a 1,500 ton reduction in greenhouse gases.
