

Accomplishments & Goals



Thanks to the generosity of Cal students, TGIF will have awarded \$1 million in grants by this year.

UC Botanical Garden eliminated use of chemical fertilizer and now produces and applies compost

the Berkeley Student Food Collective opened its storefront last November at 2440 Bancroft Way.

Installation of a hydration station in Dwinelle eliminated waste from 17743 disposable plastic bottles in just 3 months.

BSAC's projects saved 3 million gallons of water, diverted 350 lbs of waste, and reduced over 9,000 kg of CO².

BicyCal opened its free bicycle maintenance and education shop on Lower Sproul.

50% of TGIF projects have been completed and 50% are in progress.





USE ALTERNATIVE TRANSPORTATION
