Energy Incentive Program FY13-14: \$995K in Payments

The Energy Incentive Program (EIP) is an innovative approach to energy management that gives Operating Units (OUs) a financial incentive to implement energy-saving measures. OUs receive monthly meter reports indicating actual consumption relative to their historic baseline and incentive payments based on their performance. In this second year of the program, it is returning almost \$1 million to campus units, a noticeable increase over last year. In addition, no Operating Units were assessed overage charges, as all were under their baselines.
