UC Berkeley's Business Air Travel Carbon Mitigation Program mitigates the high carbon impacts of business air travel by investing in campus programs that reduce the campus carbon footprint!

In a typical year, the UC Berkeley community takes more than 32,000 trips, traveling over 100 million miles on business, emitting 25,000 metric tons of carbon dioxide from those trips each year.

The Business Air Travel Carbon Mitigation program adds a small fee to each business air travel trip, which helps fund impactful and innovative projects that reduce carbon and promote conservation, equity, inclusion, collaboration and cost savings. The Office of Sustainability manages the fund, including selecting projects and tracking progress.
